Position Purpose	To assist the Community Outreach team in delivering veterinary services including desexing. As a Veterinary Nurse, you are responsible for supporting the veterinarians in providing the highest level of treatment and care for all patients.		

POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES

Carry out all nursing tasks independently including (but not limited to):

- Surgical nursing including preparation of animals for surgery, anaesthetic monitoring, recovery postsurgery and administer medications as directed by the Veterinarian.
- Admit and discharge patients ensuring owners are given important information in a way they can understand.
- Communicate concerns to the Veterinarians promptly.
- Deliver a high standard of cleanliness including disinfecting all areas and equipment post-surgery and discharge.
- Complete all administration tasks to a high standard demonstrating attention to detail.
- Monitor stock control and advise Prevention Veterinarian of any ordering requirements.
- Provide general animal care, including feeding, cleaning, exercising of animals in care, without requiring any veterinary supervision or requiring additional assistance.
- Contribute to a positive and inclusive work environment by effectively communicating and working collaboratively with peers across all departments, and consistently behaving in accordance with the RSPCA Victoria values and associated policies.
- Takes reasonable care for the safety of oneself and others, whilst contributing to safe work practices at RSPCA Victoria by knowing and complying with all WH&S policies and procedures.
